As the school year begins again, we wanted to take this opportunity to remind parents that mental health services are available for your children at North Rose-Wolcott Schools. Wayne Behavioral Health Network has staff assigned to North Rose-Wolcott to provide on-site counseling.

The services are accessed by calling (315) 946-5722.

If you are uncertain whether your child would benefit from counseling, wellness screening services are also available to assess your child in the school setting. These services are offered under Child & Family Clinic Plus as an initiative from Wayne County & the State, at no cost to parents or school children. Wayne Behavioral Health Network offers Substance Abuse assessment and treatment for adolescents 16 years of age and older. Again, call 946-5722 to schedule an appointment at Wayne Behavioral Health Network.
