

# BUS RULES

## Standard of Behavior

- 1) Students are expected to practice the same kind of conduct expected in the classroom.
- 2) Students are expected to be courteous to one another and the driver. Profane language or obscenity is not allowed.
- 3) Drinking and eating on school buses is not allowed except with the permission of the bus driver and/or a teacher supervisor. If food is permitted on the bus, students are responsible to leave the bus clean.
- 4) Do not litter the bus; help keep it clean.
- 5) Cooperate with your driver. The driver can assign you to a special seat. You are expected always to follow any reasonable request made by a driver or other adult supervisor on the bus.
- 6) Smoking is not permitted on the bus. Alcoholic beverages and drugs are not allowed on the bus.
- 7) Do not damage the bus or equipment on the bus. You and your parents are responsible for any damage.
- 8) Stay in your seat on the bus. The driver cannot give full attention to driving when people move around.
- 9) For your safety, keep your head, hands and feet inside the bus.
- 10) Pushing, shoving, fighting is forbidden. Intimidation, verbal or physical will not be tolerated.
- 11) Do not tamper with emergency doors and windows or any other equipment on the bus.
- 12) Do not bring pets on the bus.
- 13) Do not bring flammable materials on the bus.
- 14) Do not throw any objects on or from the bus. Keep books, musical instruments and other articles secure so they do not injure other students or distract the driver.
- 15) Any act which endangers, impairs, or impedes the health, safety, or welfare of others on the bus will not be tolerated.
