**Student, Teacher or Staff member with NO Known Exposure has a temperature  $>100^{\circ}$  OR exhibits new or unusual symptoms of COVID-19:**

Fever, chills • Shortness of breath • Sore throat • Loss of taste or smell • Headache • Loss of appetite • Cough • Nasal congestion • Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea • Fatigue • Muscle or body aches



**REGARDLESS of vaccination status, individual must stay or return home and contact their health care provider.**



### **Alternative Diagnosis:**

Individual can return to school with a note signed by their health care provider explaining the alternate diagnosis.

*\*Alternative diagnosis must also be approved by school health office*



### **Negative COVID-19 test result:**

Individuals can return to school if they present with copy of negative test result and are fever-free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications and other symptoms are improving.



### **Positive COVID-19 test result:**

Individuals will be placed in isolation by the DOH and can return when they have met criteria for discharge and have been released from isolation by the DOH.



### **No Test/No Alternative Diagnosis:**

Schools will monitor these individuals and they can return when they've met the following criteria:

At least 10 days have passed since start of symptoms

**AND**

Symptoms have improved

**AND**

Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.
