

# Our Community Reads

Dear NRWE Families,

We are very excited to kick-off a literacy initiative we will begin this week. Our school community has partnered with Wayne County Literacy Volunteers and the Wolcott and Rose Public Libraries to promote literacy development, book check out at our community libraries, and families reading together. Below you will find the different parts of our "Our Community Reads" Program and how to work with your child to earn community and school incentives for **READING** at home!

## Public Library Video Series

- Visit the NRW website and / or the NRW Facebook Page to see video clips from the Rose and Wolcott Public Libraries. You can learn about how to get your child a library card, how to check out books (in person or virtually), and even see a tour of each library.

## Book Check-Out Stamp Card

- Head to one of the public libraries and get a student library card.
- Bring the attached Book Check-Out Stamp Card with you to the library!
- For every book you check out, your child will receive a "book" stamp on the stamp card.
- When your stamp card is filled up (12 stamps for 12 books checked out), take your card to one of the businesses listed on the back of the stamp card for a reading incentive!
- Contact your teacher for a new Stamp Card!



## Read It - Log It! Incentive

- Each month your child will receive a reading log to complete.
- Each time your child reads for 20 minutes, color in one of the pictures.
- Once the reading log is complete, a parent/guardian can sign the bottom.
- Have your child bring the reading log to school to pick out a NEW book donated by the Wayne County Literacy Volunteers
