ATTENDING ATHLETIC EVENTS IN WAYNE COUNTY

Per NYS Department of Health guidance, players, coaches, officials, event personnel, and only 2 spectators per player are allowed for contests. Wayne County Athletic Association, in conjunction with the FLHSAA, and Section V have developed procedures to assure that only 2 spectators per player are in attendance. These procedures will be communicated through coaches, school districts. The 2 spectators per player will be strictly enforced.

Attending Events in Wayne County

- Names of parents/guardians/spectators for athletes will be collected by coaches and will be provided to the WCAA Athletic Directors to place on a spectator list for each individual team at each Wayne County school.
- Each supervisor, at each Wayne County school, will check off each person who attends the event, ID will be checked. If a person attends an event who is not on the list, said individual will not be allowed on the school grounds and be asked to leave.
- Spectators must social distance unless with family and wear masks at all times.
- No concessions stands will be available at any contest
- All parents/guardians/spectators/athletes will be asked to go to their vehicles as soon as the event has been completed while following social distancing protocol. No congregation of fans and athletes will be allowed after said events. All athletes will meet their rides home in the parking lot of each Wayne County school.
- Hand Sanitizer stations will be provided at each event and all spectators are asked to sanitize their hands frequently through the contest.

Pre and Post Game Announcements

Soccer:

- Athletes are to go out to their positions and will be introduced while on the field
- The National Anthem will be played after introductions of athletes
- Post-game announcement instructions will be to remind all spectators to go straight to their vehicles following social distancing protocols
- Ball kids will wear rubber gloves

Game Expectations

- Have hand sanitizer available everywhere
- Soccer balls sanitized and placed on cones during games, but not required
- Athletes will wear a mask at all times, unless an athlete can not tolerate the mask. Once the athlete is able to pull the mask up, the athlete will do so.
- XC will have staggered starts
- Tennis - athletes will need to sanitize hands, not tennis balls until after the match.
