The North Rose-Wolcott Central School District has been informed that three students within the same family have tested positive for COVID-19. The students last attended school on Tuesday, April 27. The district is working with the Wayne County Department of Health (DOH) to ensure we take all necessary steps to support the health and safety of our school community.

We are gathering information for contact tracing and will be working with the DOH to determine next steps. The district will continue to monitor the situation in collaboration with the health department and will communicate with families if further action is required on the part of the district.

Through the process of contact tracing, the DOH will direct close contacts to quarantine if necessary. The DOH will directly contact any families or staff if additional action is required. If you have not been contacted by the DOH, no additional actions are required.

As a reminder, please monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and call your regular health care provider if you develop symptoms. For a complete list of symptoms, visit the CDC website at www.cdc.gov/coronavirus. Symptoms usually appear within 2-14 days from the last day of exposure. Please continue to practice good hand hygiene, wear face coverings in public, maintain social distancing, and avoid large gatherings.

We continue to work with the DOH to ensure the safety of our students, staff and families during this time. The health and wellness of our NRW community is our primary concern.
